



BARGAINING UPDATE #3

Dear

On Friday, 2 December, University management issued the **Notice of Employee Representational Rights** (NERR) to staff. The NERR sets out who the Agreement will cover and your right to have a representative during the bargaining process. Sending the NERR is required by legislation, but it's also an important signal that bargaining is coming!

There's no need for you to take any further action, but just know that the NTEU will be acting as your bargaining representative, and we are here to ensure your voice is heard in the bargaining room.

The first meeting between University management and your NTEU bargaining team will be Thursday 8 December.

What will happen at this meeting?

This meeting will be mainly administrative – establishing protocols, agreeing on regular times to bargain, ensuring staff on the bargaining team are given sufficient time release to prepare, and setting up a tentative order of the issues we want to discuss. Our priorities, as determined by members are set out in our **Log of Claims document**

Immediately following each meeting the NTEU will be in communication with members. If you have any questions about bargaining please get touch with the UNDA Branch Committee at unda@nteu.org.au
